





SUBJECT: Environmental Management System (EMS) Significant Aspects for Calendar Year 2011

1. Moody AFB's EMS implementation plan calls for an annual evaluation of environmental aspects affecting the base. In conformance with the plan, 23 CES/CEAN conducted an aspect ranking meeting on 16 February 2011. Moody AFB chose to continue with the Energy aspect that was chosen in 2009 and 2010. The goals and objectives will be re-evaluated and updated to reflect opportunities in 2011.
2. In 2010, Moody AFB was 1.4 percent below the 40 percent AF Standard for the reduction of solid waste disposal. As a result, Solid Waste Management was chosen to replace Construction Stormwater Discharge as our second significant aspect. Per Executive Order 13514, in 2015 the required solid waste diversion rate will increase to 50 percent. In anticipation of this requirement, Moody AFB will prepare through public education, squadron involvement, and stabilization of the program.
