MEMORANDUM FOR ALL MOODY AFB PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: Order Regarding Off-Base Bars, Nightclubs, Clubs, and Indoor Dining

1. Based on the Public Health Emergency Officer's (PHEO) recommendations and in accordance with the most recent *Renewed Declaration of a Public Health Emergency*, dated 20 October 2020, the following order is in effect, as follows:

a. Moratorium on Off-Base Bars: Effective immediately, all Moody AFB uniformed personnel in an active duty status are prohibited from entering or visiting any indoor or outdoor bar, pub, or other similar commercial establishment. For purposes of this order, bars and pubs are those establishments that primarily serve alcohol, including outdoors bars or beer gardens. This moratorium shall remain in effect for thirty (30) days from the date of this order (18 January 2021), unless it is renewed.

b. Moratorium on Off-Base Nightclubs and Clubs: Effective immediately, all Moody AFB uniformed personnel in an active duty status are prohibited from entering or visiting any indoor or outdoor club, night-club, gentleman's club, ladies club, or other similar commercial establishment. For purposes of this order, club or night-club refer to nighttime entertainment establishments that primarily serve alcohol or play music. This moratorium shall remain in effect for thirty (30) days from the date of this order (18 January 2021), unless it is renewed.

c. Moratorium on Off-Base Indoor Dining Restaurants: Effective immediately, all Moody AFB uniformed personnel in an active duty status are prohibited from dining indoors at any type of off-base eatery to include fast food, counter service, table service restaurants, or other similar commercial establishment. For purposes of this order, indoors includes traditional buildings, tents (unless sides have been removed), domes, fully enclosed porches, or other similar locations. Outdoor dining and takeout food is authorized if members are wearing a mask while indoors waiting seating or food. This moratorium shall remain in effect for thirty (30) days from the date of this order (18 January 2021), unless it is renewed.

2. Violations of this order and any order issued pursuant to the public health emergency can result in discipline under Article 92, Uniform Code of Military Justice.
