

Below are the changes and the current status of items of interests for the 10 pm roll up today, March 25th.

#### 1. Health Protection Condition (HPCON) Charlie

Moody Air Force Base increased its Health Protection Condition (HPCON) to Charlie today to combat the spread of the COVID-19 across the Department and Defense and our local communities. Under HPCON C, Moody Air Force Base personnel, residents and community should expect the following:

- > To abide by the installation commander and local government's orders (STAY-AT-HOME Order and Emergency Management Protection Order)

- > A Public Health screening for base entry (screening will be located outside of the bases single point of entry, Davidson Road gate); expect traffic/delays

- > Limited/restricted installation access to official business only for visitors (passes will no longer be issued for those visiting base for un-official purposes; visitors who already have issued passes are asked to restrict to official business; 100% CAC ID check)

- > To continue strict hygiene

- > To follow COVID-19 medical guidelines released by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Georgia Department of Public Health, and the 23d Medical Group

Active Duty Service Members with symptoms of fever and cough, or shortness of breath are to report to MDG employee parking lot for drive-through screening daily from 0800-0900.

#### 2. Base Access Health Screening -- STOP-CHECK-GO

Beginning 0600, 26 March 2020, there will be a STOP-CHECK-GO health screening before base entry at the Davidson Rd Gate. This screening will consist of a questionnaire regarding physical health and travel history as well as a temperature check. Expect and plan appropriately for the potential of travel delays.

#### 3. Stop Movement

UPDATED 25 March 2020—

CONUS to CONUS (to include AK, HI and U.S. territories) travel is NOT authorized at this time. For the purpose of this message, the United States and its territories is not considered a Level 2 (COVID-19) location.
