The DFAC is closed until 26 March 2020. Mealcard holders will receive BAS for this period and end of month paycheck should reflect this allowance. Commissary and BX are open normal business hours. MREs are available for purchase at the DFAC Friday from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. Military members should contact your First Sergeant for more information.

Active Duty Service Members with two or more of the following symptoms (Fever, Cough, Shortness of Breath) are to report to MDG employee parking lot for drive-through screening March 13-15 from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. Please see comments for more info on screenings. Personnel should use the Davidson Gate when entering Moody AFB.

TRICARE Beneficiaries that are feeling ill should contact the TRICARE Nurse Advice Line (1-800-874-2273) for further direction. Non TRICARE Beneficiaries that are feeling ill should contact their primary care physician for further direction.

SECDEF issued Stop-Movement Guidance for all DoD uniformed personnel, civilian personnel and family members traveling to, from, or through CDC level 3 countries for the next 60 days. Military personnel will be quarantined IAW the following rules: Quarantine for 14 days after returning to North America if travel included a stay or layover in a Level 2 or 3 country. This is effective retroactively.
